WHITE WINES

Domaine La Taste - A Crisp, juicy white from a family owned estate in Gascogne.

Pinot Grigio Ca'Stella - From Friuli in north-eastern Italy which has perfect conditions for Pinot Grigio. Lots of zesty lime fruit

Orangerie Chardonnay - From the cooler western side of the Languedoc. Elegant and unoaked with plenty of citrus fruit and buttery notes

Domaine de Morin Langaran Picpoul de Pinet - Crisp, juicy white from the Mediterranean. Full of fresh citrus flavours, with hints of pear and lime zest

Domaine du Vaux Saint George Touraine Sauvignon - A delicious Sauvignon from the Loire valley. Lots of crisp lemony citrus with notes of green apple and gooseberry

Grillo 2015, Casino, Sicily - A full bodied white with with mellow citrus and hints of minerality

Azumbre Verdejo, DO Rueda, Spain - This Verdejo displays citrusy, herbal flavours with a hint of fennel and an appetising freshness.

Domaine du Petit Soumard Pouilly Fume - Classic, steely Sauvignon from the renowned Pouilly vineyard. Elegant citrus with riper floral notes, backed by crisp minerality

Clarence River, Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand - This Marlborough SB is a modern classic. Intense elderflower aroma with crisp granny smith, grapefruit and gooseberry

Domaine de la Meuliere Chablis - A rich powerful Chablis, made from mature vines up to 60 years old, situated in one of the top premier cru sites.

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

Vino Vispo, Frizzante – This lightly spritzed Italian is perfect if you want an easy drinking alternative to white wine. Gently sparkling – not meant to be very fizzy, which is why it is so easy to drink. Lovely stone fruit flavours

Phillipe Herard – A fresh, zingy sparkler made in the traditional champagne method from all white grapes

Champagne Paul Herard – This is full, fruity champagne made in the south of Champagne from 100% Pinot Noir. Lots of strawberry fruit balanced by crisp acidity

RED WINES

Terres d'Orb - A warm, soft Cabernet and Grenache blend from the Languedoc

L'Orangerie Merlot – A delicious, easy drinking Merlot from the south of France. Lots of soft, dark, blackberry fruit and smooth tannins.

Palacio de Otono Rioja Crianza – Classic Rioja from the warm Baja region. Generous bramble fruit and dark cherry backed by toasted oak and vanilla

Inacayal Malbec, Argentina – Deliciously concentrated Malbec from prime Lujan de Cuyo vineyards, in the upper Mendoza valley. Ripe bramble and plum fruit with notes of vanilla.

Domaine de Calbric Pinot Noir – Velvety Pinot Noir from a leading estate in the Corbieres. Bright raspberry fruit with hints of Morello cherry and redcurrant

Domaines Andre Aubert, Cotes du Rhone – A classic Cotes du Rhone made from old vine Grenache and Syrah. Lots of spicy dark fruit.

Moremma Toscana, Tuscany, Italy – This is a baby super Tuscan which uses a Bordeaux blend with an introduction of Sangiovese. It's soft and fruity with cherry, chocolate and a little spice.

La Cachette de Parsifal, Reserve Cabinet, Syrah d'Oc – A bright, aromatic Shiraz with generous ripe berry flavours and a touch of vanilla and chocolate.

Domaine Billard Burgundy Pinot Noir – Classic Pinot Noir from Burgundy's famous Cote d'Or. Generous raspberry and strawberry fruit.

Inacayal Malbec Single Vineyard – This exceptional Malbec is made from hand-picked fruit and has been aged in French oak for 18 months. Complex and intense with plum, dark cherry, tobacco and chocolate.

Berthet Rayne - Chateaufort du Pape – Perfectly combines finesse and power, this gold medal winning wine is a great example from this famous region.

Chateau de Terrefort Lescalle, Bordeaux – An easy-drinking Merlot based Bordeaux from the famous Haut-Medoc. Lots of soft cassis fruit and velvety tannins
